

**Supplemental Statement of Kevin Bowers  
President of WTLW TV**

American Christian Television Services, Inc. (ACTS), the owner of WTLW(TV), conducted a survey in April 2022 involving a sampling of former WTLW viewers located in Hancock and Hardin Counties. Out of 45 responses, 17 viewers either moved to cable service or another multi channel service provider. Of the 14 respondents that continue to receive WTLW programming, most are located within the Bluffton and Ada areas, where they receive WTLW programming through a simulcast on WOIW-LD. Of the 14 respondents that receive their TV service through antenna and have lost WTLW programming, most are located within the Findlay area of Hancock County or the Ada and Kenton areas of Hardin County.

I have included in Attachment A hereto comments that we received in response to our survey.

A DRDRT on channel 32 will help address the reception issues confirmed in our survey by filling in coverage in areas that do not receive an acceptable signal from WTLW and are not covered by WOIW-LD.
