FCC Violations During the Preceding License Term

KGO Television, Inc. ("KGO-TV"), licensee of television station KGO-TV, San Francisco (Fac. ID No. 34470 (the "Station")), submits this additional statement regarding its violations during the preceding license term.

In an order by the Chief of the Enforcement Bureau dated August 15, 2019 and accompanying Consent Decree (DA 19-620), ABC, Inc. ("ABC"), indirect parent of KGO-TV's licensee, KGO Television, Inc., admitted that it had broadcast and transmitted on October 3, 2018 over the ABC Television Network an episode of the late-night talk show *Jimmy Kimmel Live!* ("the episode") that contained Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA) tones in the absence of an actual emergency, authorized test of the EAS, or qualified PSA, and ABC admitted that the broadcast of the tones during the episode violated Commission rules governing the use of WEA and Emergency Alert System (EAS) tones. See 47 CFR § 11.45. In the Consent Decree, ABC agreed to implement a compliance plan and pay a \$395,000 civil penalty. The broadcast and transmission of the episode by ABC over the ABC Television Network included its broadcast over the facilities of Station.
