

Request for Silent Special Temporary Authority

HC2 Station Group, Inc. (“Licensee”) respectfully requests Silent Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to remain silent while it repairs its permanent broadcast facility for this Class A Television Station.

The specific reason for the period of silence is due to burned portions of a coax cable. The Licensee is working diligently with the local engineer and transmitter vendor to resolve the outage as quickly as possible. Once the coax cable is replaced, the station will return to licensed operations.

Granting this request would not implicate Section 312(g) of the Act, which generally limits silent station authorizations to 12 months.¹ In contrast, the STA requested here would be for a period of up to six months.
