RE: License and Construction Permit
Expiration

Dear Former Licensee/Permittee:

This is with respect to the stations listed in the attached Appendix. Commission records indicate that you failed to file an application for license to cover prior to the stations' construction permit expiration dates.¹ Section 74.788(b) of the Commission's rules states that:

Any construction permit for which construction has not been completed and for which an application for license or extension of time has not been filed, shall be automatically forfeited upon expiration without any further affirmative cancellation by the Commission.²

As such, the construction permit was automatically forfeited on January 10, 2022. In addition, section 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules provides that:

After 11:59 p.m. local time, [[July 13, 2021], low power television and TV translator stations may no longer operate any facility in analog (NTSC) mode and all licenses for such analog operations shall automatically cancel at that time without any affirmative action by the Commission.³

Accordingly, pursuant to sections 74.788(b) and 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules,⁴ the construction permits for the stations referenced in the attachment have been **AUTOMATICALLY FORFEITED**, the licenses were **AUTOMATICALLY CANCELED**, and the stations' call signs **HAVE BEEN DELETED**.⁵ All authority to construct or operate the stations has **TERMINATED**. Furthermore, any pending applications **HAVE BEEN DISMISSED**.
