

## **Supplemental Response to Alien Ownership Questions**

WLTV License Partnership, G.P. is ultimately controlled by TelevisaUnivision, Inc. (“TelevisaUnivision”),<sup>1</sup> whose ownership continues to comply with the FCC’s January 21, 2022 Declaratory Ruling allowing TelevisaUnivision to exceed the 25 percent foreign ownership benchmark in Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.<sup>2</sup> There has been no new cognizable foreign ownership, and TelevisaUnivision’s alien ownership remains consistent with the permitted equity and/or voting interests of those foreign entities and individuals to whom the FCC’s Declaratory Ruling granted specific approval.<sup>3</sup>
