Tolling Request

Dear Mr. Skall:

On August 11, 2022, we received the request for tolling of the construction deadline that you filed on behalf of Central Baptist Theological Seminary of Minneapolis (CBTS) for a construction permit (Construction Permit File No. 0000142489) (permit) for FM Translator Station K250BY, Minneapolis, Minnesota (Station). That permit was granted on July 5, 2022 for a three-year term ending on July 5, 2025. In your request, you state that a petition for reconsideration of the grant of the permit was filed on August 4, 2022 by Park Public Radio Inc. This request falls within one of the criteria for tolling in 47 C.F.R. §73.3598(b) and is granted.

Grant of the request is subject to the following conditions:

Tolling is effective as of July 5, 2022. Once tolling ends, the full three-year term will remain.

Tolling will remain in effect until April 13, 2023, absent earlier resolution of the petition for reconsideration. If the matter is not resolved within six months, CBTS would need to file a status report by April 13, 2023 and at six-month intervals thereafter, requesting continued tolling treatment.

CBTS also must notify us within 30 days of the petition for reconsideration being resolved.

Status reports must be sent by letter to Secretary, FCC, 45 L Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20554 with a courtesy copy by e-mail to Victoria McCauley (Victoria.McCauley@fcc.gov).

When tolling ends (either because CBTS has not filed a request for continued tolling or because the matter has been resolved), we will calculate a new permit expiration date by adding the remaining three years.
