Informal Objection

Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration: (1) the above captioned minor change application (Application) to change channel from 229 to 221; (2) the Informal Objection filed by LKCM Radio Licenses, L.P. (LKCM) on June 7, 2021; (3) all related pleadings. For the reasons set forth herein, we grant the Informal Objection and dismiss the Application.

LKCM, licensee of KTFW-FM, Glen Rose, Texas, filed an Informal Objection stating that the proposed translator on channel 221 will cause interference to listeners of KTFW-FM. LKCM states that this proposed facility is in violation of section 74.1204(f) of the Commission's rules (Rules)¹. In order to provide convincing evidence under section 74.1204(f) that grant of the translator construction permit "will result in interference to the reception" of an existing full-service station, an opponent must provide, at a minimum: (1) the required number of listener complaints² based on the population of the complaining station; (2) complaint letters³ signed and dated by the listener; (3) map showing the specific location of the complaints inside the 45 dBu contour of the complaining station; (4) statement that the complaining station is operating within its license parameters; (5) the complaining station has tried to inform the translator licensee and attempted to resolve the alleged interference; and (6) U/D data demonstration that the listeners are within the area predicted to receive interference.


² The required minimum number of valid listener complaints as determined using Table 1 to 47 CFR § 74.1203(a)(3) and defined in 47 CFR § 74.1201(k).

³ As proposed in the *NPRM*, we will define a listener complaint as a complaint that is signed and dated by the listener and contains the following information: (1) the complainant's full name, address, and phone number; (2) a clear, concise, and accurate description of the location where the interference is alleged to occur; (3) a statement that the complainant listens to the desired station using an over-the-air signal at least twice a month, to demonstrate the complainant is a regular listener; and (4) a statement that the complainant has no legal, employment, financial, or familial affiliation or relationship with the desired station, to demonstrate the complainant is disinterested.

The petitioner has submitted all the required documentation from over 8 listeners that certified they are listeners of KTFW-FM and live, work or travel within the predicted interference area of the proposed translator.

Accordingly, the Informal Objection filed on June 7, 2021 by LKCM Radio Licenses, L.P. IS HEREBY GRANTED and the Application File No. 124943 IS HEREBY DISMISSED. These actions are taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
