

Renewal of License – Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule Narrative

HC2 acquired the license for KCCX-LD, Facility ID: 68454, Corpus Christi, TX pursuant to an assignment application. The Assignor was: Mako Communications, LLC. The Lead File Number was: BALDTL-20170918ACA and the Member File Number was: BALTTTL-20170918ACC. The acquisition was consummated on 12/26/2017. Accordingly, the certifications contained in this narrative cover the period from 12/26/2017 to the present.

The station went silent on 4/12/2019 and filed a Silent Special Temporary Authority (“Silent STA”) request, FCC File Number: 0000071900 on 4/18/2019. The specific reason for the period of silence was, “The Station was taken off the air as part of the process of collocating the station with station K20JT-D, also owned by Licensee. As part of the collocation of broadcast facilities, both stations had to be temporarily taken off the air while the Licensee continues to evaluate engineering solutions associated with the new master antenna for the stations. The stations have engaged consulting engineers to resolve these ongoing master antenna issues, and the Licensee plans to resolve these issues as soon as possible.” The Silent STA was granted on 4/18/2019.

The station inadvertently did not file an extension to the Silent STA in a timely fashion.¹

The station resumed operations on 1/23/2020 when it filed a License to Cover, FCC File Number: 0000106120 on 1/23/2020. The License to Cover was granted on 1/27/2020.

Since that date, the station has been operating pursuant to its authorized specifications.
