Children's Programming Commercial Limitations

On the station's main digital stream from November 15, 2017, through December 1, 2017, the Unimas Television Network aired two consecutive half-hour episodes of the animated television program *Pokemon* between 4 pm and 5 pm EST, Monday through Friday, for a total of 5 hours per week. (On December 4, 2017, the station switched programming from UniMas to Univision Network.) During that period, each one-hour block of the *Pokemon* program contained a total of 15 minutes and 45 seconds of commercial time, i.e., 3 minutes and 45 seconds over the 12 minutes per hour limit on commercial time during children's programming. The cumulative overage over these 13 days was 45 minutes and 25 seconds. After discovery of this overage in January 2018, the Unimas Network reformatted this program to limit the total amount of non-program time to no more than 12 minutes per hour.
