FCC Violations During Renewal Term

In 2017, the FCC issued a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (DA 17-501, released May 24, 2017) against the former licensee of KIEM-TV, Pollack/Belz Broadcasting Company, LLC (“Pollack/Belz”) for violations of Section 73.3526 for failure to timely upload documents to KIEM-TV’s online public file; and Section 73.3514(a) for failure to disclose these violations in its 2014 renewal application (FCC File Number BRCDT-20140801AKA).

KIEM-TV was assigned from Pollack/Belz to the current licensee, Redwood Television Partners LLC (“Redwood”) in 2017 (FCC File Number BALCDT-20170822AAS). The control of Redwood was transferred from NBI Holdings, LLC to CMG Media Corporation (f/k/a Terrier Media Buyer, Inc.) dba Cox Media Group (“CMG”) on December 17, 2019 (FCC File Number BTCCDT-20190304ACI).
