FCC Violations

On September 21, 2022, the Commission released a *Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture* (FCC 22-70) (“*NAL*”),¹ finding that New Age Media of Pennsylvania License, LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of WOLF-TV, Hazelton, Pennsylvania (Facility ID No. 73375), together with a number of other broadcast television licensees, apparently violated Section 73.670 of the Commission’s rules by failing to comply with the limits on commercial matter in children’s programming by airing the programming discussed in the Children’s Programming Commercial Limitations Exhibit to this instant license renewal application.² The Commission prescribed a forfeiture for Licensee in the amount of \$40,000 for these apparent violations.³

On October 21, 2022, Licensee filed a response to the *NAL*, in which it requested that the Commission: (1) stay the issuance of any monetary forfeiture against Licensee resulting from the *NAL* until the Commission has acted upon the response to the *NAL* being filed by Sinclair Broadcast Group, Inc. (“Sinclair”), the provider of the programming and advertising in question; and (2) consolidate any subsequent forfeiture proceedings against Licensee and the other broadcast television licensees listed in the *NAL*.⁴

The proceeding remains an open matter before the Commission as of the filing of the instant license renewal application.
