K24ML-D, Taos, NM (Facility ID No. 60791)
License Renewal Amendment Exhibit

Licensee Son Broadcasting, Inc. (Son), is amending the K24ML-D License Renewal Application submitted on June 1, 2022 (LMS File No. 0000192620), to update its response to the TV Translator/LPTV Certifications Section "Silent Stations" question from "no" to "yes." K24ML-D resumed normal operations on October 31, 2022, and is currently on the air broadcasting programming intended to be received by the public (LMS File No. 0000203361).

K24ML-D was granted Special Temporary Authority on March 15, 2022, after it went silent around January 5, 2022, following a storm that caused a commercial power outage (LMS File No. 0000180526). The translator did not recover after power was restored. At that time, K24ML-D could not be reached for repairs due to snow conditions. Later, wildfires limited accessibility to K24ML-D, and there was no incoming over-the-air program feed from its primary station, KCHF, Santa Fe, New Mexico (Facility ID No. 60793) because wildfires had forced KCHF to operate from its auxiliary site (LMS File No. 0000190353). The licensed power from the auxiliary site provided an insufficient signal to feed the Taos translator. K24ML-D was granted an extension of Special Temporary Authority to remain silent on July 7, 2022 (LMS File No. 0000193802).

K24ML-D resumed operations on October 31, 2022, following the restoration of power to the main KCHF transmitter on August 2, 2022, and the subsequent completion of necessary repairs to K24ML-D (LMS File No. 0000203361).
