

**SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS NOTIFICATION
AND REQUEST FOR SILENT AUTHORITY STA
K277CV TUCSON, AZ**

This technical statement was prepared on behalf of Arizona Lotus Corp. (“Lotus”), the licensee of FM translator station K277CV (Facility ID No. 155925), to not only notify the FCC Audio Division staff retroactively that K277CV has temporarily suspended operations, but to request Special Temporary Authorization (STA) to remain silent until service can be restored using the technical parameters specified in the station’s outstanding construction permit.¹ The FCC granted the assignment application for K277CV on October 7, 2022 and Lotus took control of the station as the new owner on October 19, 2022.² At this point it became necessary for K277CV to temporarily suspend operations until the station is able to restore service using its CP parameters.

Upon discovering that the required notification and request for silent authority were inadvertently not filed timely, Lotus is now taking all appropriate steps to rectify this oversight. Lotus also intends to modify K277CV’s CP parameters in such a way that the translator will be able to expeditiously resume on-air operations using an existing antenna that it will share with another co-owned translator.
