

WWMT aired in excess of 1,400 PSAs in 2022 covering topics such as Domestic Abuse, Gun Safety, Suicide Prevention, Literacy, Adoption, Wildfire Prevention, Disaster Relief Efforts, Alzheimer's Assistance, Breast Cancer Awareness, Feeding America, Adoption, Saving Money, St. Jude Hospital for Children, Shriners Hospital for Children, Buzzed and Drunk Driving Prevention, Diversity and Inclusion Awareness, Red Cross, Salvation Army, Big Brothers Big Sisters, and Project Roadblock.

WWMT supports Sinclair Cares, a variety of informative stories tackling issues affecting adults and their families that were shared with viewers throughout 2022. Examples of topics are Ukraine Relief, Feeding Children, and Recycle Batteries.

WWMT sponsored a "Roof Sit" in partnership with a local radio station in May 2022. A 3-day outdoor event with a silent auction along with a parking lot dinner helped raise over \$90K for the Community Healing Center. All proceeds go to help treat children suffering from abuse and neglect.

WWMT held its annual "Share the Warmth" coat drive in October 2022 in partnership with the Salvation Army. This coat drive benefits kids in need of winter gear. The event brought in over 1,000 coats and 100s of other winter wear items such as scarves and gloves.

WWMT sponsored "Serve for Kids" in October 2022. This tennis clinic, dinner, and online auction raised over \$97K for the Community Healing Center. This helps in the prevention of child abuse and neglect.

WWMT sponsored a "Red Kettle Marathon" in partnership with the Salvation Army in November 2022. WWMT Sports Director Andy Pepper rang bells at various locations for 18 hours straight. This event raised over \$9,200 and helps recruit volunteers throughout the holiday season to help 'ring the bell'.
