

## Station KTNV-TV 2022 Children's Television Programming Report

Station KTNV-TV believes it substantially complied with the FCC rules regarding broadcast of children's educational/information programming during calendar year 2022 and submits this explanatory exhibit in an abundance of caution to provide additional details regarding the station's programming efforts.

As reflected in the report, children's E/I programs Outback Adventures and Hearts of Heroes (2) were moved from KTNV-TV's primary channel 13.1 to its multicast channel 13.2 in February 2022. Episodes of those programs originally scheduled to air on KTNV-TV's multicast channel 13.2 were preempted due to technical issues on March 19 and on May 28. In both instances, the preempted episodes were made good within 7 days on the station's primary Channel 13.1. However, due in part to the same technical difficulties that caused the episodes to be preempted, the station was not able to broadcast on-air notifications of the rescheduled dates and times for those episodes. Information regarding the May 28 preemptions was provided to program guide providers; the make-goods for the March 19 preemptions were aired before such notices could be provided. While KTNV-TV has treated these episodes for purposes of this report as regularly scheduled, licensee notes that were they considered non-regularly scheduled episodes of educational/informational programming, KTNV-TV's programming would continue to satisfy the Commission's rules under Category A, Option 2.
