Notifying Publishers of Program Guides

Licensee currently provides information identifying programming specifically designed to educate and inform children (“Core Programs”) to publishers of program guides as required by 47 CFR Section 73.673 of the Commission’s rules.

It was recently learned, however, that during parts of the reporting periods for calendar year 2021 and calendar year 2022, that is, from March 2021 through October 2022, information identifying each Core Program that aired on Licensee’s station inadvertently was not provided to publishers of program guides.¹ Upon learning of the oversight on November 10, 2022, the Licensee acted promptly to ensure that the provision of information identifying each Core Program to publishers of program guides resumed, and the information continues to be provided.

Licensee takes its responsibilities under the FCC’s children’s television programming rules very seriously. Licensee is committed to serving its viewers and providing those viewers as well as program guides with information about its Core Programming that meets the educational and informational needs of children.
