Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a minor change to a licensed facility.

An engineering study has revealed that the transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of section 73.807 of the Commission's rules (Rules).¹ Specifically, the site proposed is short-spaced to the licensed facilities (0000157041) of co-channel station W276DV, Miami, FL.² The subject application proposes to reduce the spacing to W276DV from 24.3 km (at the WUGR-LP license site authorized in BMLL-20190820AAS), to a distance of 18.47 km. The distance required by the Rules is 26 km. The applicant recognizes this defect and requests use of a directional antenna in an attempt to overcome the short-spacing and to protect co-channel station W276DV. However, the Rules do not accommodate the use of directional antennas to protect domestic co-channel stations.³ The applicant fails to address this defect. Therefore, the application is unacceptable for filing and will be dismissed.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application 0000153315 IS DISMISSED pursuant to section 73.807 of the Rules. This action is taken pursuant to section 0.283.⁴
