

**WKBS, Altoona PA (Fac. Id. 13929)**  
**License Renewal Application**  
**OPIF Explanation**

In reviewing its online public file in preparation for renewal, WBCP noted only five instances where uploaded documents reflect a date after the upload deadline. However, after further review, only three of those instances appear to be actual late uploads and only a few days in each case.

First, the Q2 2017 issues and programs list was uploaded one day late, as was the Q2 2017 children's television commercial limits certification. Second, the Q3 2018 children's television commercial limits certification has the same upload date as the Q3 2019 certification (10/3/2019) but a review of the OPIF history folder indicates that a Q3 2018 certification was timely uploaded and later deleted and replaced because it was mis-labeled. Finally, the 2016-17 EEO public file report was uploaded 3 days late, and the 2018-19 EEO public file report was uploaded on March 26, 2020 at the same time as the 2019-20 report. WKBS believes that a timely upload attempt was made for the 2018-19 report during March of 2019, but failed and was not discovered until later. WKBS has confirmed that the 2018-19 EEO public file report was in fact timely posted to and available to the public on the station's website during the entire time period that the report did not appear in the public file.
