K24FH-D, Glide, Etc., Oregon, Facility ID No. 50585, was silent pursuant to Special Temporary Authority from January 13, 2020, until April 21, 2020. *See* LMS File No. 0000099022 (Silent STA Request granted Jan. 21, 2020). *See also* LMS File No. 0000105685 (reduced power Technical STA granted Mar. 4, 2020) and LMS File No. 0000114140 (reduced power notification filed May 21, 2020).

On January 13, 2020, K24FH-D was forced off the air because its tower fell as a result of ice accumulation.

Oregon Public Broadcasting (OPB) was able to return K24FH-D to air on April 21, 2020, using a single Kathrein broadband UHF panel at 5 meters above ground level, at reduced power pursuant to a Technical STA granted on March 4, 2020 (LMS File No. 0000105685).

K24FH-D was again silent pursuant to Special Temporary Authority from September 10, 2020, until December 28, 2020. *See* LMS File No. 0000129387 (STA request withdrawn on Dec. 29, 2020, and dismissed as moot on Dec. 30, 2020).

On September 10, 2020, OPB first discovered that K24FH-D had been forced off the air resulting from a wildfire that swept through the Glide, Oregon, communications site. OPB was able to rebuild the temporary facilities authorized in the granted Technical STA and restore service on December 28, 2020. The Technical STA is currently extended through August 28, 2023 (LMS File No. 0000210637).
