

Next Generation TV Multicast Statement

CBS Broadcasting Inc. (Paramount), licensee of KCBS-TV Los Angeles, CA (Facility ID 9628), respectfully requests authorization to commence ATSC 3.0 operations from host facility KCOP-TV Los Angeles, CA (Facility ID 33742).¹

The FCC rules permit ATSC 1.0 stations to request approval to transition to the ATSC 3.0 “Next Generation” television standard. This statement shows that the proposed KCBS-TV operation would comply with the coverage requirements in the rules.

Paramount is proposing to continue broadcasting KCBS-TV programming from the existing ATSC 1.0 facility that operates on channel 31.² A substantially similar ATSC 3.0 simulcast of KCBS-TV is proposed to operate on channel 13 via Lighthouse station KCOP-TV, which will serve as the host. As the host and guest stations are both located within the Los Angeles DMA[®], continued coverage requirements of the ATSC 1.0 and 3.0 signals are assured.³
