

US Stations LLC Transfer of Control

Transaction Description.

There is no written agreement for this transaction which results as a matter of law from the April 2022 death of Charles R Shinn, Trustee of the Charles R Shinn Revocable Trust and the transfer of control to successor trustees.

Licensee US Stations, LLC, is controlled 52% by CSMAG Holdings, LLC. (KQUS & KZNG & KLXQ BTCH-20110914ACK; KLAZ & KLBL & K288FP BALH-20160802AAG; K250CE BNPFT-20171201ANG).

Pursuant to the terms of its LLC Operating Agreement, CSMAG Holdings LLC is controlled 100% by its LLC Managing Member: Shinn Enterprises, Inc., which was at all times in turn 100% controlled by Charles R Shinn.

For estate planning purposes, Charles R Shinn conveyed his individual ownership interest in Shinn Enterprises, Inc., to his Charles R Shinn Revocable Trust which has not been previously disclosed to the Commission through a proforma application.

The Charles R Shinn Revocable Trust is the 100% voting shareholder of Shinn Enterprises, Inc. Charles R Shinn was the sole grantor, sole beneficial owner, and sole voting trustee of his revocable trust.

Charles R Shinn's trust document provides that upon his death, the 100% voting interest held by Shinn Enterprises, Inc., in CSMAG Holdings LLC shall be voted by the unanimous consent of special trustees Alice M Shinn, Gregory R. Shinn and Pamela Shinn Spelman.

Accordingly, this application proposes a transfer of 52% voting control of licensee US Stations, LLC from Charles R Shinn to unanimous joint control by Alice M Shinn, Gregory R Shinn and Pamela Shinn Spelman.
