I herewith submit a request to change the virtual channel of KILA-LD Cherry Valley, CA FCC ID# 129642 to Virtual ch 19.

Attached is a map showing the contours and coverage of two other stations using virtual ch 19 in the South Western Part of the US along with the contour and coverage of KILA-LD.

The stations studied are:

- 1) KBBV-CD Bakersfield, CA FCC ID# 69735. This station has a single record, its licensed facility. This was the facility considered and shown on the map.
- 2) KHDF-CD Las Vegas, NV FCC ID# 66807. This station has two records - its licensed facility and a CP to increase power from 7.5 KW ERP to 15 KW ERP using the same site and the same antenna and orientation. The licensed facility contour is entirely within the contour of the CP facility. The larger CP facility is the facility considered and shown on the map.
- 3) KILA-LD Cherry Valley, CA FCC ID# 129642. This station has two records - its licensed facility and a CP to change location, antenna and increase power. The licensed facility contour is entirely within the contour of the CP facility. The larger CP facility is the facility considered and shown on the map.

There were no other stations identified within 500 KM of the proposed KILA-LD transmitter that use virtual ch 19.
