

***Pro Forma* Transfer of Control Application**  
**Family Broadcasting Corporation**  
**Description**

There are no written agreements memorializing the proposed transfer of control. Applicant is a non-profit, non-stock corporation with a self-perpetuating board of directors. Applicant seeks approval for a gradual transfer of control of its board of directors that exercise voting control. For the reasons set forth below, the change is *pro forma* in nature, and meets the FCC's requirements for a Form 2100, Schedule 316 "short form" transfer of control.

The FCC last approved a short-form transfer of control for Family Broadcasting Corporation (fka LeSEA Broadcasting Corporation) in BTCH-20130204ABD on April 2, 2013. At that time, a three-member board was approved consisting of Peter Sumrall, Angela Grabowski and Keith Passon. In 2015, Peter Sumrall was replaced by Andrew Sumrall, leaving the remaining two previously approved members, Grabowski and Passon, with a combined 66.6% of the vote, in control. Keith Passon is now leaving the board and being replaced by Adam Sumrall, the result of which will be a greater than 50% voting control change since the FCC's 2013 approval. Family Broadcasting Corporation now seeks FCC approval of the proposed three-member board consisting of Andrew Sumrall, Adam Sumrall and Angela Grabowski.

This application is filed concurrently with three other applications seeking *pro forma* transfer of control approval of the following related non-profit broadcast licensee corporations with identical board history and current proposed changes, and for which Applicant is also the parent.
