

**EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES FOR  
OPERATING FM BROADCAST STATION KMLY  
TEMPORARILY AT REDUCED POWER**

Lazer Licenses, LLC (“Lazer”), the licensee of FM broadcast station KMLY Ch. 236A Gonzales, CA (Facility ID 164096), hereby requests Special Temporary Authorization (STA) for KMLY to continue operation at reduced power. KMLY has been operating at reduced power to help minimize the impact of third-order intermodulation interference on WQWG322, which is a licensed station in the land mobile radio service that is owned and operated by the County of Monterey (hereafter “the County”).

Lazer and the County have been working together to remedy the interference since the issue began, but up to this point they have not been able to mitigate the interference completely. However, the County recently added two new transmit frequencies to its station license that are not expected to mix with the existing FM signals at the site, which should eliminate the third-order intermodulation products that have been effecting the County’s receive frequencies.

The County is working to transition over to the new transmit frequencies within the next few weeks and, at their request, Lazer has agreed to reduce KMLY’s transmitter power output from 2.4 kW down to 0.4 kW (or 1.0 kW ERP) for the interim, which the station did on April 21, 2023. Lazer apologizes for failing to timely request an STA for KMLY to remain operating at reduce power.
