## Explanation of FM License to Cover Filing and Compliance with Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions

1. The applicant certifies coordination with other users of the site to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

*2. The applicant would like to note Spurious Emissions measurements as required by 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d) have not been taken, as diplexing with the co-owned facilities of License BLFT-20120208ADC (W209CL - Washington, IN; FAC ID: 83669) will not occur. At the time, W209CL - Washington, IN; FAC ID: 83669 will be taken silent; with the WYHN(FM).C - Washington, IN; FAC ID: 762135 operation, notified herein, assuming sole operation into the antenna. A relocation, sale or surrendering of the W209CL - Washington, IN; FAC ID: 83669 license will be determined at a later date.*

3. The applicant acknowledges that subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, subsequent acts and treaties, and all regulations heretofore or hereafter made by this Commission, and further subject to the conditions set forth in this permit, the permittee is hereby authorized to construct the radio transmitting apparatus herein described. The applicant certifies that installation and adjustment of equipment not specifically set forth herein has been made in accordance with representations contained in the permittee's application for construction permit except for such modifications as are presently permitted, without application, by the Commission's Rules (See Section 83.875).

4. The applicant acknowledges that pursuant to Section 73.3598, this Construction Permit is subject to automatic forfeiture unless construction is complete and application for license is filed prior to expiration. In this instance, construction has been completed and an application for license filed prior to the expiration of the Construction Permit.

5. The applicant certifies that equipment and program tests have been conducted pursuant to Sections 73.1610 and 73.1620 of the Commission's Rules.
