Dear Brad--

On January 9, 2023, we sent the attached letter by email to Mr. Carb and Mr. McCutchen. At that time, we did not serve you as Mad River's counsel. In the letter, we canceled the Mad River permit for Channel 249C1 at Loleta, and ordered Mad River Radio to refile a new application for construction permit for Channel 249C1 at Loleta within 30 days. To date, Mad River has not refiled an application for construction permit. In light of the fact that we did not serve you as counsel, we are hereby granting an additional 30 days for Mad River to re-file its application for construction permit for channel 249C1 at Loleta. If Mad River does not file its application by August 12, 2023, we will remove the condition on Miriam Media's permit and allow it to file its application for license for Channel 254C1 at Ferndale, thereby negating the implied STA that Mad River has been using to operate on Channel 256C1, and KJNY will be required to cease broadcasting.
