Dear Mr. Joshua Turiel:

This is in response to your email dated June 23, 2023, regarding the vessel BANGOR, O.N. 3529, and the visual-signal KNNE.

In accordance with your application, the Federal Communications Commission has been notified today of the cancellation of the visual-signal KNNE formerly assigned to the subject vessel.

The task of issuing call signs resides with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The United States Coast Guard's role with the FCC is strictly in a research capacity, determining whether the vessel is in service, and the call sign is still active. If the vessel has been deleted from documentation, the U.S. Coast Guard does not object to having the call sign reassigned. If the vessel's Certificate of Documentation is valid, the U.S. Coast Guard states that fact and indicates that the call sign is still in use, and, therefore, unavailable for reassignment.
