

## **STA EXTENSION REQUEST**

### **K29OC-D, Chapman, KS**

The instant STA Extension Request is being filed for K29OC-D, Chapman, KS. K29OC-D went silent on 5/10/2023 for technical reasons, and a Request for STA was filed. See LMS File No. 0000214755. That original Request for STA was granted per FCC authorization dated May 22, 2023, with an expiration date of November 10, 2023. See attached authorization letter.

K29OC-D has continued to experience problems which prevent it from broadcasting. In its attempt to resolve the technical issues, K29OC-D has been and will continue to search for a new permanent broadcast site. Thus, the instant STA Extension Request is necessitated. It is hereby requested that K29OC-D's current STA be extended six (6) months, to May 10, 2024.
