Dear Licensee:

This letter is to inform you that the license of Station K25KY-D, Fresno, California (Station), licensed to Edge Spectrum, Inc. (Edge), has automatically expired pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (Act),¹ its license has been cancelled and its call sign has been deleted.

Section 312(g) of the Act provides that “[i]f a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term, or condition of the license to the contrary....”² According to Commission records, the Station went silent “on or around April 7, 2022,” when according to Edge it was informed that its station could no longer operate from its current site.³ Edge went on to state that it was “currently evaluating options for a new tower site” and expected to resume operations “as soon as possible and within the six month period of the STA.”⁴ The Commission’s records do not indicate that Station resumed operations and as a result its license automatically expired, as a matter of law, on April 8, 2023, pursuant to section 312(g) of the Act.⁵

Accordingly, we find that the Station’s license has automatically expired pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 312(g) and the license of low power television station K25KY-D, Fresno, California, **IS CANCELLED**,

its call sign **DELETED**, and all pending applications **ARE DISMISSED**.⁶ All authority to operate the Station **HAS BEEN TERMINATED**.⁷

Accordingly, we take this opportunity to remind Edge of its obligation to file complete and accurate information in all applications filed with the Commission. See e.g. 47 CFR § 1.17 (truthful and accurate statements to the Commission); 1.65 (substantial and significant changes in information furnished by applicants to the Commission); 73.3514 (content of applications). Failure to do so in the future may result in sanctions, including forfeiture.
