



RADIO FREQUENCY IMPACT, SAFETY & STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE

The formerly licensed KMPH-TV facility was previously evaluated for human exposure according to methodology set forth in OET Bulletin 65. The resulting power density attributable to the facility is $1.440 \mu\text{W}/\text{cm}^2$ which for an “uncontrolled environment” is 0.39% of the maximum permitted exposure limit for the general population.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 1.1307(b)(3) of the FCC Rules, because the proposed facility would not exceed 5% of the uncontrolled and controlled exposure limits, the proposal's power density contribution is considered insignificant. Further, the Applicant will continue to cooperate/coordinate with other site users and reduce power and/or cease operation during times of service or maintenance of the transmission systems as necessary to avoid potentially harmful exposure to personnel. In light of the above, the proposed facility should be categorically excluded from RF environmental processing under Section 1.1307(b) of the Commission's Rules.
