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## **TRANSFER OF CONTROL DETAILS**

This application is being filed to reflect the addition of board members in order to recover from previous attrition and to comply with Florida corporation law. We are also filing this application to bring the station into compliance with Commission rules.

With that said, on a separate Administrative Update, we will be changing the name of the licensee to Iglesia de Dios Amor y Misericordia, Inc. ("IDAM") This is the actual name of the corporation that is on file with the State of Florida. The corporate entity has never changed and the governance document that was used for the original construction permit (BNPL-20131113BLP) is the same one that is in effect today. Because the corporate entity is not changing and the organization has remained consistent since the original 2015 grant, this application is being filed as a *pro forma* transfer of control.

As of January 23, 2020, the members included Eric Perdomo (President), Ray David Velazquez (VP) and Caroline Cancel (Secy./Treas.). On August 30, 2020, Caroline Cancel left the board making IDAM a two-person corporation. On February 17, 2021, Ray David Velazquez left the board, making IDAM a single person corporation. The instant application brings the corporation back to a three-person board.

IDAM has been under new leadership since 2019 and has reached out to REC Networks for assistance in bringing the station into compliance.

## **ALIEN OWNERSHIP**

The instant application indicates Juan Manuel Villalta (“Villalta”) as a voting member. Villalta is a citizen of El Salvador. He will have a 20 percent vote on the board. As this corporation only has no more than 20 percent of its total vote by aliens, the licensee continues to comply with §310(b)(3) of the Communications Act.<sup>1</sup>
