**Explanation re Children's Programming**

Broadcasting Licenses, Limited Partnership ("CMG") requires its stations to comply with all FCC rules, including the rules on children's television programming. KLSR-TV's compliance with the FCC's children's television programming requirements is detailed in the quarterly and annual children's television programming reports that KLSR-TV has filed with the FCC, all of which are incorporated by reference herein.

CMG notes that, on May 2, 2022, the station's ownership changed pursuant to an assignment of license application. *See* FCC File No. 0000185519. Because of the long-form ownership change, the current owners and licensee are not liable for violations of the prior owners and licensee. However, CMG notes that, based on CMG's review, the prior licensee may have, in some instances, over reported the amount of children's programming that aired on the station's main channel and digital subchannel(s). Since CMG acquired the station in May 2022, KLSR-TV has been compliant with the Commission's Children's Television Programming rules and Core Programming requirements.
