

Online Public Inspection File Certification

Broadcasting Licenses, Limited Partnership (“CMG”), licensee of, KSLR-TV, Eugene, Oregon, hereby certifies that except as described herein, KLSR-TV has timely placed in its online public inspection file all documents required to be placed in the file by 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526 and otherwise has complied with the Commission’s public inspection file requirements in all material respects. CMG notes that, on May 2, 2022, the station’s ownership changed pursuant to an assignment of license application. *See* FCC File No. 0000185519. Because of the long-form ownership change, the current owners and licensee are not liable for violations of the prior owners and licensee. However, in an abundance of caution, CMG notes that not all documents may have been uploaded to the online public file in a timely manner by the prior licensee.

CMG requires its stations to comply with all FCC rules, including the rules for the political public file. CMG employees are trained on FCC political public file compliance before and throughout each election cycle and are provided with tools and checklists to assist with maintaining complete and timely records. While CMG believes KLSR-TV has complied with the political public file requirements, in a few instances, some information may have been uploaded to the political public file outside of CMG’s requirement that all documents be uploaded within one business day. When late uploads occur, CMG employees are required to review the situation and make any needed corrections to station processes to ensure timely uploads going forward.
