

Purpose of Amendment

This amendment is submitted pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, to advise the Commission of a recent involuntary assignment of the broadcast station license of KRCK-FM, Mecca, California (FCC Facility ID No. 52808, "Station"), to the bankruptcy estate of the prior licensee, now controlled by a trustee appointed by a bankruptcy court, and to update other responses on the pending renewal application (LMS File No. 0000155212, the "Renewal Application") more generally.

As this renewal application was originally filed, the "applicant" was the licensee of the Station at that time, a former receiver appointed by a court, W. Lawrence Patrick, Receiver ("Patrick"), see CDBS File No. BALH-20200716AAD, for the previous licensee of the Station, Major Market Radio, LLC ("Major Market"). Patrick was then removed as receiver, with the Station's license assigned back to Major Market (now in bankruptcy) as a "Debtor in Possession" ("Major Market DIP"), see LMS File No. 0000184726; it appears no amendment of the renewal application was filed to reflect this change. Subsequently, the bankruptcy court appointed Michael W. Carmel, Esq., as the Chapter 11 Trustee ("Trustee") for the bankruptcy estate of Major Market; the Commission consented to the involuntary assignment of the Station's license to the Bankruptcy Estate of Major Market Radio, LLC (FCC Registration Number 0033806902, the "Bankruptcy Estate"), controlled by the Trustee, on June 20, 2023, see LMS File No. 0000215223, which was consummated the same day.

One purpose of this amendment is to update the pending Renewal Application to reflect that the "applicant" should now be the Bankruptcy Estate, controlled by the Trustee (please note that the Commission's Licensing and Management System does not permit the "Applicant" name to be changed by amendment, so the first line under "Applicant Name, Type, and Contact Information" in the "Applicant Information" section of the application still references Patrick, before then otherwise giving the information about the Bankruptcy Estate and the Trustee).

This amendment also changes the response to the "FCC Violations During the Preceding License Term" certification question to "No" and provides a responsive exhibit, addressing notices of violations and a letter of inquiry directed to prior licensee Major Market which were issued after Renewal Application was filed.

Last, this amendment also supplements Patrick's exhibit to the Renewal Application regarding compliance with the online public inspection file requirements, and specifically regarding quarterly issues/programs lists, to provide more detail and request a waiver of Section 73.3526 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(12).
