

WPGH is pleased to broadcast programs in standard program lengths three hours weekly, which provides educational informational needs of children. We believe these programs have unlimited value. During this past quarter, WPGH telecast numerous public service announcements aimed at children 16 years of age and under. Examples include: Child Mind Institute, Feeding America, Foster Care in the USA, Foundation for a Better Life, National Park Foundation, Nourishing Neighbors, and Peace Corps. Our PSAs are designed for a general audience, but also serve children 16 years of age and under. Our general audience programs which serve children 16 years of age and under include our local news which airs every weeknight at 6:30pm, and every night at 10:00 p.m. WPGH also produces a monthly public service campaign called "Staying Aware" that features local non-profit organizations. Finally, WPGH produces the bi-weekly Steeling the Spotlight, an on-air and online campaign that features Pittsburgh residents who have overcome adversity to excel in the community
