

**Explanatory Exhibit Regarding CP Condition**

Forum Communications Company (“Forum”), licensee of KSFL-TV, Sioux Falls, S.D. (Facility ID No. 29121) (“KSFL” or the “Station”), respectfully provides this explanatory exhibit regarding its certifications to the questions whether the facility was “constructed in compliance with all special operating conditions, terms, and obligations described in the construction permit” and whether all conditions “set forth in the underlying construction permit have been fully met.”

Forum recently acquired KSFL via a long-form assignment application. *See* LMS File Nos. 0000204329 (assignment application); 0000211144 (consummation notification). Upon assuming control of KSFL’s technical facilities, Forum discovered that various repairs, updates, and modifications needed to be performed to KSFL’s broadcast equipment in order to correct lingering technical issues and to ensure resilient broadcast operations going forward. *See, e.g.*, Various STAs under KSFL’s prior licensee, from December 2014, CDBS File No. BLSTA-20141217AAX, to September 2020 extension, LMS File No. 0000121320. Forum began diligently performing those corrective tasks throughout 2023 and the facility’s antenna was replaced on October 26, 2023; regrettably, Forum commenced operations with the new antenna prior to sending letters to health care facilities, an issue that was discovered during the notification letter process. Forum has received no outreach from medical facilities—either before or after the notification letters were transmitted—nor is Forum aware of any instances of medical devices malfunctioning or any likelihood that such devices might malfunction due to KSFL’s DTV operations. Additionally, in conjunction with regulatory counsel, Forum has taken steps to ensure that this circumstance does not occur again.

Given the foregoing, Forum respectfully submits that there are no technical impediments to granting the accompanying application and that a grant would serve the public interest by permitting Forum to serve KSFL’s community of license with improved, resilient broadcast equipment.
