

Acquisition of Control / Noncommercial Qualification

On July 25, 2023, the Media Bureau approved the proposed assignee, Intentional Life Media (f/k/a Family Life Broadcasting System), with the same board members that are shown as having a pre-existing interest/current in the assignor, as the assignee of WDRQ, Detroit Michigan (Fac. Id. 70040) in file number 0000216676 (Form 2100, Schedule 315).

In connection with that same application, the Bureau approved ILM as qualified to be a noncommercial educational entity in connection with a simultaneously granted noncommercial educational conversion application granted in file number 0000217091. The proposed assignee, is an existing licensee of noncommercial educational stations and hereby certifies that the Commission has previously granted a broadcast that found it qualified as a noncommercial educational entity with a qualifying educational program (not only in 0000217091 but also originally in BLED-19880414IB).

As noted, Intentional Life Media's educational qualifications have previously been established and recognized before the Commission. ILM seeks to enhance educational and moral values and develop cultural appreciation. Its educational objectives are (a) to provide religious instruction and moral teaching; (b) to provide the opportunity for and to promote informative discussion and debate in areas pertaining to contemporary social and religious issues, as well as citizenship and its responsibilities; (c) to provide solutions to community problems such as teenage pregnancy, troubled youth, drug and alcohol abuse, pornography and indecency, the breakdown of the family unit, crime, the economy, the environment and education; and (d) to teach citizenship, patriotism, peaceful conflict resolution, and family life enhancement. ILM's programming is intended to educate listeners on how to respond to issues in their daily lives and covers such concerns as women's and children's issues, family relationships, financial planning, community life and old age/retirement. Sample programs include Intentional Living (focusing on the five essential areas of life that include faith, family, health, finances and work), Focus on the Family (interviews and insights on issues affecting families), In Touch (teaching on Christian faith and principles) and Turning Point (teaching practically and personally on God's word).
