Dear Mr. Sanford Cohen:

This is in response to your email dated February 5, 2024, regarding the vessel ABANDONED (EX: SALMON KING), O.N. 216542 and the visual-signal KJXL.

In accordance with your application, the Federal Communications Commission has been notified today of the cancellation of the visual-signal KJXL formerly assigned to the subject vessel.

The task of issuing call signs resides with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The United States Coast Guard's role with the FCC is strictly in a research capacity, determining whether the vessel is in service, and the call sign is still active. If the vessel has been deleted from documentation, the U.S. Coast Guard does not object to having the call sign reassigned. If the vessel's Certificate of Documentation is valid, the U.S. Coast Guard states that fact and indicates that the call sign is still in use, and, therefore, unavailable for reassignment.
