Core Programming

The children's television programming reports for the 2nd quarters of 2016 and 2017 report airing less than an average of 3.0 hours per week on the mainstream.

In the 2nd quarter of 2016, KMSB was not always able to air makegoods for preempted programming in the programs' 2nd homes. The station did not include those preempted episodes in its calculation of the average number of Core hours of children's programming aired per week on the main stream. KMSB did air six 30-minute programs each week during the 2nd quarter of 2016 and all preempted programming was made good. Make good episodes not aired in the program's 2nd home, were made good within 48-hours of the preemption. Also, KMSB aired additional children's programming during the 3rd quarter of 2016 to make up for the perceived deficit. Although, KMSB reported airing an average of 3.0 hours per week on the main stream in the children's television programming report for the 3rd quarter of 2016, it actually aired an average of 3.27 hours per week.

Similarly, in the 2nd quarter of 2017, KMSB reported airing an average of 2.5 hours of children's programming on the main stream. The station aired six 30-minute programs during the 2nd quarter of 2017. However, in its calculations the station did not include the program *Hatched* which was preempted from its primary time period and made good eight (8) times. As in 2016, KMSB reported airing an average of 3.0 hours per week on the main stream for the 3rd quarter of 2017, but the station actually aired an average of 3.5 hours per week during the 3rd quarter of 2017.
