

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The W230AY Construction Permit (File Number 0000239968) contains three Special Operating Conditions:

- 1. The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC guidelines.*
- 2. Sufficient measurements shall be made to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements shall be submitted to the Commission along with the FCC application for license.*
- 3. Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.*

Educational Media Foundation (EMF) complies with, or agrees to, the condition as follows:

1. EMF agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna.
2. Spurious Emissions Measurements have been done with the results of these measurements contained in Exhibit 1-A.
3. Form 350 is being filed prior to commencing program test operations.
