Ms. McCauley:

I write in response to the Operational Status Inquiry ("Letter") propounded to Martin Broadcasting, Inc., the licensee of Stations KZZB(AM), Beaumont, Texas, and K298CB, Beaumont, Texas, by letter dated February 27, 2024. The Letter requests a response within 30 days of its date, which we calculate to be March 28, 2024.

Martin Broadcasting, Inc. ("MBI") and an affiliate, which are minority owned and operated, are the licensees of five AM radio stations located in the state of Texas. The stations broadcast gospel programming that serves minority audiences. Owing to its ownership and program service, MBI has a limited administrative staff to deal with both regulatory and operational issues.

Under the circumstances, MBI is unable to pull together and provide the information you have requested within the period provided. MBI is hereby requesting an additional 30-day period in which to provide the responses called for.
