

Last Will and Testament

OF

CATHERINE MAE PRITTS

I, CATHERINE MAE PRITTS, of Columbus, Franklin County, Ohio, being of sound and disposing mind, and not under the restraint or undue influence of any person, do make and declare this to be my Will.

ITEM I. I revoke all Wills heretofore made by me.

ITEM II. I direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable after my death.

ITEM III. I devise and bequeath all of my property, both real and personal, to my husband, Robert Milligan Pritts, if he survives me. I make no provision herein for any child now living, hereafter born to or adopted by me, except as provided in Item IV.

ITEM IV. If I survive my husband, Robert Milligan Pritts, I devise and bequeath all of my property, both real and personal, to my children now living, hereafter born to, or adopted by me, equally, share and share alike.

ITEM V. I appoint my husband, Robert Milligan Pritts, Executor of my Will and request that no bond be required of him.

I hereby authorize and empower my executor to compromise, settle and adjust all claims and demands in favor of or against my estate; and to sell, at private or public sale, with or without court order, at such prices and upon such terms of credit or otherwise, as he may deem best, the whole or any part of my real and personal property, and to execute, acknowledge and deliver deeds and other proper instruments of conveyance thereof to the purchaser or purchasers. No purchaser from my said executor need see to the application of the purchase money to or for the purposes of the trust, but the receipt of my said executor shall be a complete discharge and acquittance therefor.

I declare this one typewritten page, consisting of five items, to be my Will this 21st day of January, Nineteen Hundred and Sixty-one (1961).
