**Interim Report on IBOC Asymmetric Sideband Operation
and Request for Extension of Experimental Authority**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 17, 2023, and pursuant to a request by Beasley Media Group Licenses, LLC (“Beasley”), licensee of WJPT, Fort Myers, Florida (Facility ID No. 74080), experimental authority (EA) was granted to WJPT to operate with asymmetric IBOC standards. See 20221026AAF. Specifically, WJPT was authorized to operate with a digital power of -10 dBc on its lower sideband and -11 dBc on its upper sideband.

Asymmetric operation has been continuous from the date of grant of EA up to and including the date of this letter. There have been no complaints of interference from any party during operation in this mode. The EA operation has been continuous and stable over the past year. Improved, stable digital reception and coverage result from the EA operation.

Based on no reported complaints of interference and the above-noted improvement in coverage and reception, Beasley hereby seeks a one-year extension of the EA.
