
On June 6, 2016, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following interference issue:

The proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. KQVE-LP – La Vernia, TX. – BLTTL-20001219AAU at 4.9%

You were given 30 days from the date of that letter to amend your application electronically to resolve the above deficiency, or we will dismiss your application.

We have received your amendment filed on July 7, 2016, our current evaluation of the interference taking into account the amended specification shows that your facility is still predicted to cause interference to KQVE-LP – La Vernia, TX. – BLTTL-20001219AAU at 4.8%. Since the amended specification did not resolve the interference issue the above referenced proposal LMS-0000010895 IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
