

EXHIBIT REGARDING LAFF AND BOUNCE PROGRAMMING

Due to a technical error, from September 10, 2016 through October 15, 2016, the following core programs, designed specifically for children, aired on the LAFF and BOUNCE networks without the required E/I symbol:

LAFF:

- Food For Thought with Claire Thomas
- Jack Hanna's Animal Adventures
- Outback Adventures with Tim Faulkner
- Reluctantly Healthy

BOUNCE:

- All In With Laila Ali
- Everyday Health
- Culture Click*
- *Culture Click also aired one additional time on November 5, 2016 without the E/I symbol.

In total, 10.5 hours of LAFF core children's programming and 12.5 hours of BOUNCE core children's programming broadcast during the last three weeks of the 3rd quarter and the first weeks of the 4th quarter did not include the required E/I symbol.

To address concerns regarding compliance with FCC requirements, during the fourth quarter, in addition to the regularly scheduled core children's programming, LAFF and BOUNCE provided, and the station re-broadcast, the programming originally aired without the E/I symbol. The re-broadcast children's programming aired each Saturday or Sunday for consecutive weeks beginning October 29, 2016 through December 4, 2016. LAFF also provided one additional half-hour of children's educational programming.

While the programming was re-aired with the E/I symbol, it was not regularly scheduled fourth quarter programming and, therefore, is not being reported as core programming. To accurately reflect the amount of children's educational programming provided during the fourth quarter, the station has reported the re-broadcast LAFF and BOUNCE programming as non-core educational and informational programming.

Upon notification from the networks of the technical error, the station took every reasonable step to remedy the situation and provide the requisite programming specifically designed to meet the educational and informational needs of children.
