KHMF has an urgent need to broadcast via this STA on channel 35 instead of their licensed Channel 14.

Ever since KHMF went on the air with Ch 14 they have had an interference problem with the First Responders in their area. They have tried numerous solutions including: different type accepted transmitters, filters, and exciters, all with no acceptable results.

The tower company has asked them to either change frequencies or move to another tower that they own. At this time, they have 30 days left to operate Ch 14, go to a different frequency, or move to another tower site. They have been on Ch 33, but have determined that Ch 35 will work the best in that location.

The public good will be served by the continued operation of this station. Rural Arkansans rely on OTA Television for Local Event, Extreme Weather conditions and entertainment. Pay TV in many cases is either unavailable or cost prohibitive in rural areas of Arkansas.
