Notification of Suspension of Operations and Request for Silent STA

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 22, 2017, Southern TV Corporation, Debtor in Possession ("Southern TV"), the licensee of television station WGSA(DT), Baxley, Georgia (the "Station"), suspended over-the-air operations and went silent.

Southern TV lost the lease for its main studio location and was required to vacate the premises under threat of eviction on April 22, 2017. The Station's over-the-air broadcasts, therefore, ceased on that date. Southern TV is currently operating in under federal bankruptcy court protection. Southern TV requests special temporary authority ("STA") to remain silent until it can locate and lease new main studio facilities for the Station and/or find a buyer for the Station's assets in accordance with its bankruptcy case plan.

The reason for the delays in (i) notifying the FCC of the discontinuance of broadcast operations, and (ii) filing this request for special temporary authority to remain silent, is because of the hospitalization, at the time the station's studio lease was lost, of Dan L. Johnson -- who is President of Southern TV.

This notification and request for STA is being filed in letter form because the Commission's LMS electronic form filing system will not allow preparation of a Notice of Suspension of Operations and Request for STA to Remain Silent if the date of suspension of operations is greater than 30 days prior to the date of creation of the form.
