

UNCONDITIONAL CONSENT AND NON-OBJECTION TO INTERFERENCE

The University of North Carolina ("UNC-TV"), licensee of WUNF-TV, Asheville, North Carolina, is seeking a construction permit from the FCC to operate its post-transition DTS facility on Channel 20.

As discussed in the Engineering Exhibit of Chesapeake RF Consultants, LLC, which is attached to WUNF-TV's minor change application, UNC-TV's proposed DTS operation on Channel 20 is predicted to cause (a) 0.55 percent new interference to WUNC-TV, RF Channel 20, Chapel Hill, North Carolina (Fac. ID No. 69080) and (b) 0.52 percent new interference to WUNG-TV, RF Channel 21, Concord, North Carolina (Fac. ID No. 69124). WUNC-TV and WUNG-TV are, like WUNF-TV, both licensed to UNC-TV. UNC-TV finds that the predicted new interference by WUNF-TV to WUNC-TV and WUNG-TV will be *de minimis*.

Accordingly, effective on the date hereof, the undersigned, a duly authorized representative of UNC-TV and television stations WUNC-TV and WUNG-TV, hereby acknowledges the foregoing and agrees unconditionally to accept (and not object to) the predicted interference to WUNC-TV and WUNG-TV from WUNF-TV's proposed DTS facility operations on Channel 20.
