Mohammad,

I have attached the OET 69 study. This study uses the CL-26 antenna as described in the displacement application, with an antenna azimuth of 31 degrees true north (instead of 30 deg.) . Not much of a change, but this clears all stations from interference including KOB1.

The counselor added the engineering for the STA. He took it on himself to input the engineering. That engineering is not valid. The only engineering that is valid is the displacement application that I filed. He should have filed a "legal" ST, as I told him.
