

Ramar Communications, Inc.
Legal STA Request

Ramar Communications, Inc. (“Ramar”) is the licensee of digital Low Power Television station K47MQ-D, Channel 47, Santa Fe, NW, Facility ID 183557 (BLDTL-20140602BBY). K47MQ-D has received a 120 day notice from a 600 MHz licensee that the wireless licensee intends to commence operations and K47MQ-D is predicted to cause interference to the wireless operations. The 120 day notice states that wireless operations will commence by October 31, 2017, in advance of the Special Displacement Window. Therefore, Ramar sought a waiver of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC’s”) Displacement Freeze (*see* Pubic Notice, DA 14-808, rel. June 11, 2014), in conjunction with the displacement application it filed today for K47MQ-D (see LMS File No. 0000030049) (the “Displacement Application”).

Pursuant to the procedures set forth in the FCC’s Public Notice, DA 17-584, released June 13, 2017, Ramar hereby seeks special temporary authority to operate on Channel 20 (as detailed in the Displacement Application) during the pendency of FCC processing of the Displacement Application. Grant of this STA request will clearly serve the public interest by allowing this facility to provide continuous service to the public during the ongoing incentive auction repacking process.
